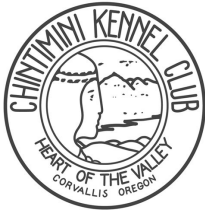
The goal of Chintimini Kennel Club is to provide a fun, entertaining event that exhibitors and especially the dogs can enjoy. Many exhibitors at our CAT events are new to lure coursing and CAT events provide an ideal place to introduce people to this dog sport. We make every effort to be welcoming to exhibitors and to the dogs. But it must be remembered that lure coursing has inherent risks to the dog. Thus, in addition to providing a fun event our number one priority is the safety of the dogs.

The CAT Evaluator is the AKC officiate at our events. It is important to us to have evaluators with documented experience to help us provide high quality events. If you are interested in participating as a CAT Evaluator we ask that you complete the form below for our records. As per AKC Lure Coursing Regulation the Evaluator determines if a dog has successfully run the course: "The Coursing Ability Test is a pass-fail event. In order to pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance."

In addition to the evaluation of each course the evaluator is expected to walk the course with the CKC Lure Operator to provide insights into the course layout for the safety of the dog.

The evaluator is responsible for properly completing the AKC Coursing Ability Test Results paper work (attached). This form will be completed by the test secretary and will include the breed name, call name, registered name and dog registration numbers. The judge ONLY checks the pass/fail boxes and signs the sheets. Please do not add any other notations on this official form.

Instructions: This form is to be used by a non-AKC Coursing Judge who wishes to be Coursing Ability Evaluator at a Chintimini Kennel Club sponsored CAT Event. The applicant must be mentored by a licensed AKC Coursing Judge at an AKC Coursing event. A copy of this Certificate must be submitted to Chintimini Kennel Club, along with other information when providing documentation to be an Evaluator at a Coursing Ability Test.
